“Millions of Canadians and thousands of companies can no longer afford universal access to good health care — not great but good.

We used to have really good health care and if you were wealthy, you could shop for great health care.

But now, everyone is threatened with the erosion of good health care and the majority of incomes and business revenue is growing at a much slower and lower rate than medicine, in all its forms.

The bottom line is that Canada can neither manage nor afford its medical needs.”
